



THE CURRICULUM LIBRARIES AT HOLY FAMILY UNIVERSITY LIBRARY AND LRC



The ground floor of the Northeast Philadelphia Library along with the Newtown LRC house extensive circulating collections of K-12 textbooks, curriculum guidelines and kits, and children's literature for the use of Education students.

Our combined collections include:

- Over 2,500 textbooks (student and teacher editions) for various subjects in all grade levels
- Over 3,100 non-fiction works for children and young adults in all subject areas
- Over 4,000 works of fiction for children and young adults
- Dozens of curriculum kits for various subjects
- A special collection of English as a Second Language materials located by the Northeast Philadelphia Curriculum Library

Policies:

- Kits circulate for one week only, and may be renewed once.
- Overdue fines for kits are \$1.00 per day.
- Books circulate for three weeks, and may be renewed once.
- Overdue fines for books are 10 cents per day.
- Students from either campus may request items from the other campus for checkout by filling out and submitting an intercampus loan form.
- Materials in the Northeast Library's ESL Collection are available for 3-week checkout by Philadelphia area public and parochial teachers - ID required. Teachers may examine all other library materials, but will need a "Friend of the Library" card or Alumni card to check them out.
